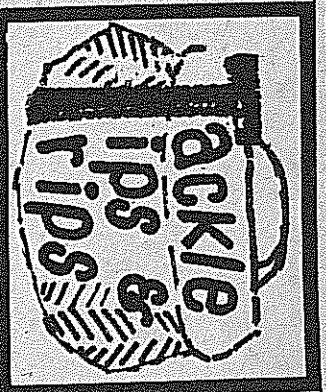

Trout fishing has slowed up some, not because there aren't any fish in the river, but it seems many anglers have given up trout fishing and turned to saltwater. One can go up to the Saugahatch and see the trout feeding on the inch worm. These worms are terrific bait when used on a size 16 hook; so they will sink very slow to make it look natural looking.

If you want to try some real good pan-fishing go up to the Saugahatch reservoir and you'll be surprised at the size of the Sunnies there.

Last week I mentioned that anyone who goes striped bass fishing may be interested in joining the Westport Striped Bass Club. They have meetings the last Thursday of the month, which is tonight at the Firehouse on Wilton Road; Hose Co. # Three. They usually start between 8 and 8:30 p.m. So, if you want to learn something about bass fishing, and meet a real nice group of guys, here is the opportunity.

Striped bass fishing is well underway now in this area with schoolies providing most of the action. There are reports of a 20 pounder being taken on the bottom with sandworms at Sherwood Island. On the surface the "SprinAtom" and "Bucktails" seem to be the best producing lures right now. If you have a boat, try fishing the islands for the bigger ones. Off shore, Compo Beach is always a good spot.

Blackfish seem to have taken over on the bottom, with catches up to thirteen pounds, the hottest spot being Sherwood Island. Flounder fishing is fairly slow off shore but still good in deeper water. Pretty soon the "porgies" will be in to add to the action for the bottom fisherman.

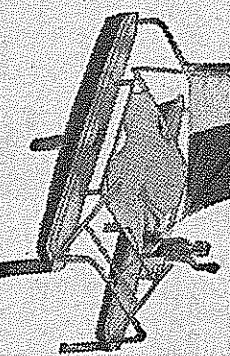

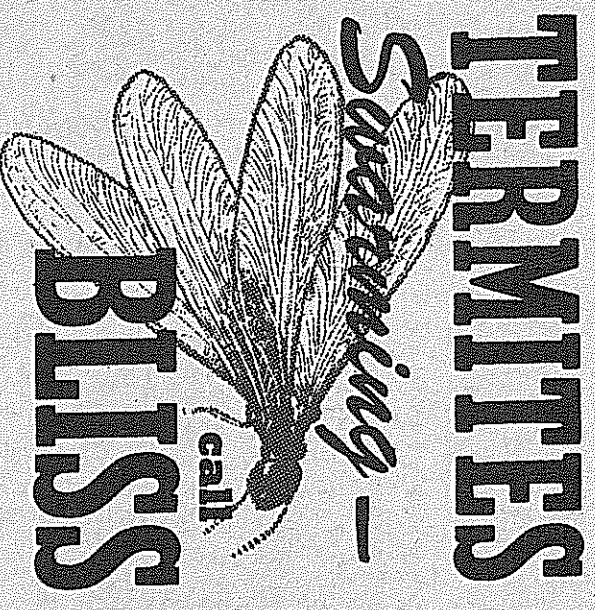
